Introduction:

Agriculture plays a vital role in Pakistan's economy and daily life. A large portion of the population is engaged in farming and livestock rearing, especially in rural areas. The major crops grown in the country include wheat, rice, cotton, sugarcane, and maize. These crops are essential not only for feeding the population but also for export and industrial use. Since many parts of Pakistan have an arid or semi-arid climate and receive limited rainfall, irrigation is necessary to supply water to the crops. The Indus River and its tributaries form one of the largest irrigation systems in the world, providing water through canals, tube wells, and dams. Agriculture and irrigation are closely connected and are key to Pakistan's food security and economic growth.

Topic: Bird Nest Craft Using a Milk Carton

Theme: "My Little Bird House"

Task:

Create a **bird nest craft** using a clean and empty **milk carton** and decorate it to look like a cozy home for birds. This activity encourages you to recycle materials and show creativity while learning about how birds live and nest.

Materials Needed:

- Empty milk/juice carton
- Scissors and glue
- Colour paper, markers, paint (any available)
- Natural materials (twigs, grass, yarn, etc.)
- Old newspapers or cotton for the nest
- Decorative items (optional)

Steps to Follow:

1. Take a clean and dry **milk carton** (or any juice carton of similar size).
2. **Cut out a small round or square opening** in the front for the bird to enter. Ask an adult for help while using scissors.
3. Paint or cover the carton using **coloured paper, paint, or fabric scraps**.
4. Use **twigs, dry grass, yarn, cotton, or shredded paper** inside the carton to make the bird's nest.
5. You may add **paper birds or eggs** to show your creativity.
6. Decorate the outside using **buttons, leaves, flowers, beads, or stickers** if available.
7. Write 3–5 lines on a slip of paper and paste it behind or under your craft. Include:
 - What materials you used
 - Why you enjoyed this activity
 - One fact about bird nests
8. Bring it to school after holidays.
